Introduction

South East Manipur College was established in the year 1981. The College was affiliated to Manipur University in 1983 and was granted permanent affiliation in 1992. The College has offered courses in both Arts and Science streams upto degree level and was recognized by the University Grants Commission in 1994 under section 2 (f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act 1956.

College Status

- In pursuance of the State Cabinet decision/approval taken on 9/5/2016, the Government Department of Higher & Technical Education, Manipur issued order vide No.31/3/AIDED-COLL/DEMDS/HE-16 dated 11/05/2016 for giving of additional Government approved posts of teaching & non-teaching staff i.e. 20 teaching and 10 non-teaching. This is in addition to the previous approved posts of 10 teaching and 7 non-teachings.
- The College has an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The IQAC was established on 21st April, 2014. The IQAC monitors in the effective implementation of the curriculum to bring quality education. It also maintains accountability and transparency in the overall administration of the College.
- The College is accredited with B-Grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore on 16th September, 2016 with a CGPA of 2.35 on a seven-point scale for a period of 5 (five) years.
- The College Hostels (Boys & Girls) are completed and 100 bedded Sports Hostel is under construction.
- The College Library is equipped with 7416 books and reference books. INFLIBNET is available which has enabled the availability of books and e-journals. Internet is available under National Mission on Education through Information & Communication Technology (NME-ICT) and broadband wireless services. The Library is fully automated. The Library has 1 Server, 1 computer for circulation section, 1 computer for OPAC, 1 printer, 10 computers for accessing e-resources.
- Botanical garden is flushed with varieties of flowers and medicinal plants.
- The College has drinking water facility with a Cooler cum filter of 300 liters for staffs and students.
- The College has its own Canteen in the Campus.

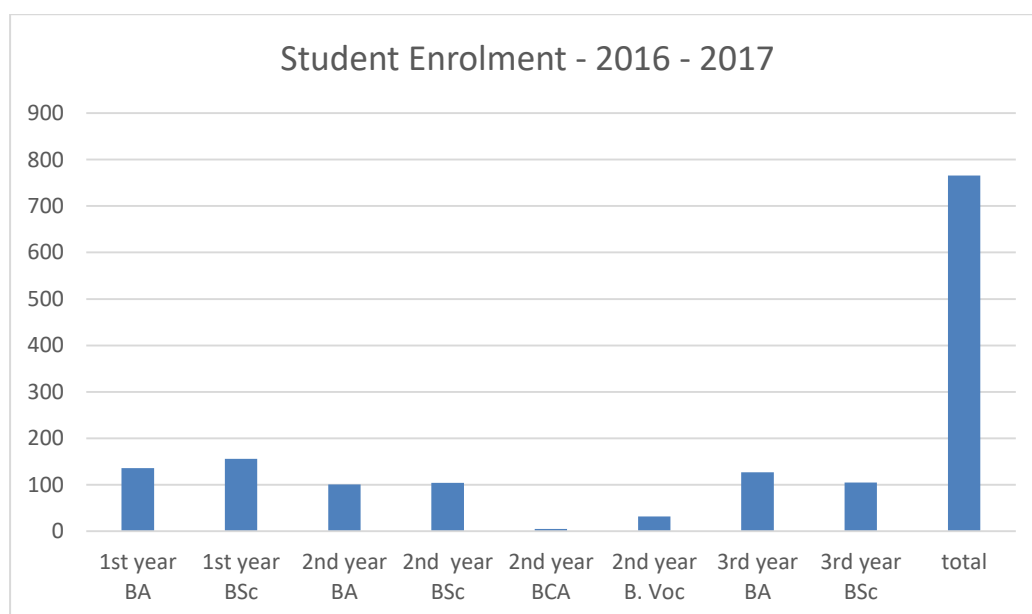
College Activities and Programmes

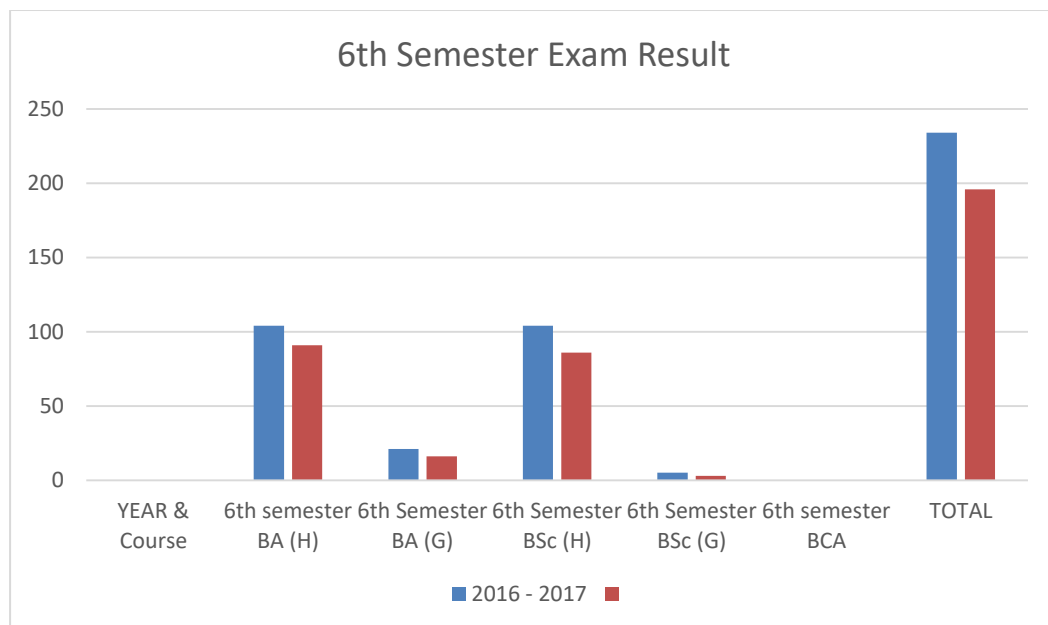


Academic Performance of the students
